Title: One day webinar on occasion of "World Environment Day - 2021".


Timing of the webinar: Morning 10.00 am, on 5th of June, 2021.


Participant: Webinar was open for all students from Nabira Mahavidyalaya, Katol, Students of other colleges and schools, and all people in society.

One Day Botanical Excursion Report

Title: "One Day Botanical Excursion to Ayurvan Aura Park".

Date: Tuesday, 25th February, 2020.

Department of Botany have organised a one day Botanical Excursion for B.Sc. Sem-II and Sem-IV students, as a part of regular activity mentioned in university syllabus. *This tour was organised as a collaborative activity between the Botany Department and Ayurvan Aura Park, Nagpur.* Students were taken to visit the Ayurvan Aura Park placed in Kathlabodi village near Bajargaon. The place is around 37 km from our college. Aura Park is a part of Ayurvan Foundation established by Mr. Ambarish Ghatate. This place is very enchanting and is dedicated for the conservation of medicinal plants diversity. There are more than 1000 species of different medicinal plants mentioned in Indian Ayurveda are cultivated here. The staff involved in the activities have detailed knowledge about the cultivation and medicinal uses of all these plants.

20 students of B.Sc. Sem-II and 20 Students of B.Sc. Sem-IV along with all the staff of botany department left for the Aura Park at 9.00 am by bus and reached at the destination at around 10.15 am. We had an introductory remark along with breakfast and students were educated about importance of our Indian traditional system and heritage traditional medicines. Then, students were grouped into to two groups and one group taken on one side of the farm and other on other. In the afternoon students have enjoyed lunch prepared by farm grown organic vegetables. In the post lunch session students were taken to Nakshatra-Van and explained about

the relation between our Indian Astrology and the plants related to them and their effect on

human life. It was an enchanting experience.

At the end we sign the Memorandum of Understanding between Ayurvan foundation and

Department of Botany, Nabira Mahavidyalaya Katol for helping each other in research activities

related to Ayurveda and Ayurvedic plants. We left the place around 5.00 PM and reached the

college around 6.00 PM. Students enjoyed the tour a lot as they got the opportunity to spend

quality time with nature and learned a lot about the importance of our Indian Ayurvedic Culture.

Number of beneficiaries: Total 38 students of B.Sc. Botany Sem-II (18) and Sem-III (20) got


benefited from this tour.
