INTRODUCTION

The aim of this document is to help the Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) students at our campus and create awareness in general so that they can get appropriate assistance in many forms which shall uplift them and have a seamless movement while they are with us.

The objectives of the policy are:

- Smooth and effective implementation of all legislations relating to Divyangjan.
- To ensure early detection, inclusion in education, skill building and appropriate.
- Provide necessary facility, welfare aids, and required provisions.
- Suitable regulatory mechanism for effective delivery of services to Divyangjan such as in learning methods, admission, examination.
- Avoid discrimination, exploitation and exclusion of Divyangjan from all spheres of campus life.
- Take suitable care of Divyangjan with high support needs due to disability, family.

Types of Assistances offered by Institution:

- 1. **Wheel Chair-** The institute has 02 Wheel Chairs available at the main gate as well at the administrative office.
- 2. **Ramp** Our new building has facility of ramp to assist the PWD.
- 3. **Elevator -** Our new building has elevator / lift which PWD can use.
- 4. **Physical Support** PWDs are also manually assisted and supported whenever required especially at the main gate.

- 5. **Preference** At all places viz. admissions, fees, exam form counters, and regular / practical classes etc. the PWDs are given first preference.
- 6. **Dedicated Helpline-** College has dedicated helpline upon which the PWDs can make a telephone call and seek for any related kind of help.
- 7. **Attempt for Door Step Services-** Our endeavor is to support the PWDs by avoiding them to report to college wherein it's not compulsory. In such cases, assistance is give while they are at home.
- 8. **Separate PWD Toilet-** Our campus has one exclusive and dedicated toilet which is made as per the needs of PWDs.
- 9. **Railing Support at Staircases** The staircases have a "railing" support which assists the PWDs in old buildings.
- 10.**Doctor on Call** The institution has tie up with 02 dedicated doctors who are kind enough to attend the students in case of any medical emergency.
- 11.**In-house Medical Facility** We have stretchers, sick room, and basic first aid facility for all the students.

Team of Volunteers– A constituted team act as volunteers who supervise, assist and can be contacted by any of the PWDs.
