



The Compliance Report to be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 10,000/- in the form of demand draft in favour of Member Secretary, AICTE, New Delhi. In the absence of compliance with the above conditions, the Institute will be required to submit the Compliance Report alongwith requisite processing fee by 31st August every year irrespective of the period of approval.

The above proposed annual after rectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of and aid for providing infra-structure, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time for the Institute requiring expansion.
- That the Institute shall be made only after adequate infra-structure and other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- That the admission shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
- That the curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation/assessment of students and fee structure conform to the norms prescribed by the AICTE.
